## **JOB DESCRIPTION**

### **General Summary/Objective**

Under minimal supervision perform operation and maintenance of the wastewater collections system.

### **Essential Functions**

1. Work in a crew to perform general maintenance of the wastewater collection system.
2. Locate waster collections lines and manholes, excavate and repair lines when needed.
3. Repair customers yard/landscaping when required.
4. Check and maintain pump stations, and various equipment, make repairs when needed.
5. Record charts change charts and keep accurate logs.
6. Check and maintain sewer pump stations.
7. Observe standard safety precautions and practices.
8. Follow state and federal laws and regulations.
9. Operate and perform general maintenance with equipment including power and hand tools, backhoe, ditch witch, air compressor, jack hammer, jet truck, dump truck, etc.
10. Responsible for keeping wet wells clean by using chemicals and/or jet truck.
11. Interface with customers on complaints and inquiries.
12. Interface with contractors and assists with line locations.
13. Attend meetings and continuing education courses.
